

Load ALL400s to IBM i 7.1 and 7.2

Follow these instructions if you want to save copies of the ALL400s utilities from PUB400 if your IBM i is at version 7.1 or 7.2.

- Create the FASTLIVE and FASTBREED libraries on your IBM i.
- Go to the ALL400s home page, click on Resources, then click on Demos.
- Click on 'Get ALL400S71 save files'.
- An ALL400S71 zipped file should now be on your Desktop. Take the 'Extract All' option for that zipped file. This will create an ALL400s folder on your desktop.
- FTP the SAVEQGPL71.SAVF to the QGPL library on your system
- FTP the SAVELIVE71.SAVF to the new FASTLIVE library on your system.
- FTP the SAVEFAST71.SAVF to the new FASTBREED library on your system.
- Restore the objects in each save file to the libraries they're in.

That's it. All of the ALL400S utilities and applications on the PUB400 Demo System should now be live on your system. There will also be a few custom commands available if you add FASTBREED and FASTLIVE to your library list.

Keying SLL on a command line will put the libraries you need in your library list.

Keying FASTBREED on a command line will bring up the ALL400s menu.

If you're going to use the Source archive you might want to copy/add FASTBREED/ARCOPTS to the QGPL/QAUOOPT file. That will give you the options you need for PDM. STRPDMX does the same thing but it temporarily overrides QAUOOPT to ARCOPTS so the normal options won't be there if you need them.

** I'd make sure the FASTBREED library was at the bottom of your library list. The naming conventions I used should keep there from being any conflicts with other objects but you never know - why risk it by putting it at the top of the list.

ALL400s' Custom Commands and Shortcuts

Once the FASTBREED library is in your library list you have access to other custom commands I wrote. Some of them are just simple abbreviations and some are shortcuts to each of the ALL400s utilities.

aj Work with active jobs
dm Displays messages
dspip. Display your system's IP address
findx. Searches for string you key in, ignoring your library and
object types. An asterisk can be used for generic search.
off. Sign off.
scnmsgf. . . . Prints list of messages that have your search string.
spl. Work with spool files.
sll. Add FASTBREED and FASTLIVE to your library list.
ADDRESS. . . . Brings up Address Book application.
ARCHIVE. . . . Brings up Source Archive application.
EXPENSE. . . . Brings up Expense Reporting application.
FAQ. Brings up FAQ Tracking application.
FASTBREED. . . Brings up the whole list of ALL400s applications.
HELPDESK . . . Brings up HelpDesk application.
HELPER Brings up the limited User Side of HelpDesk application.
PMENU. Brings up the old programmer menu.
SPOOL. Brings up the Spool Tracker system.
STRPDMX. . . . Brings up PDM with only the Source Arhive options on it.
TBL. Brings up the Valid Values table for adds/changes.
